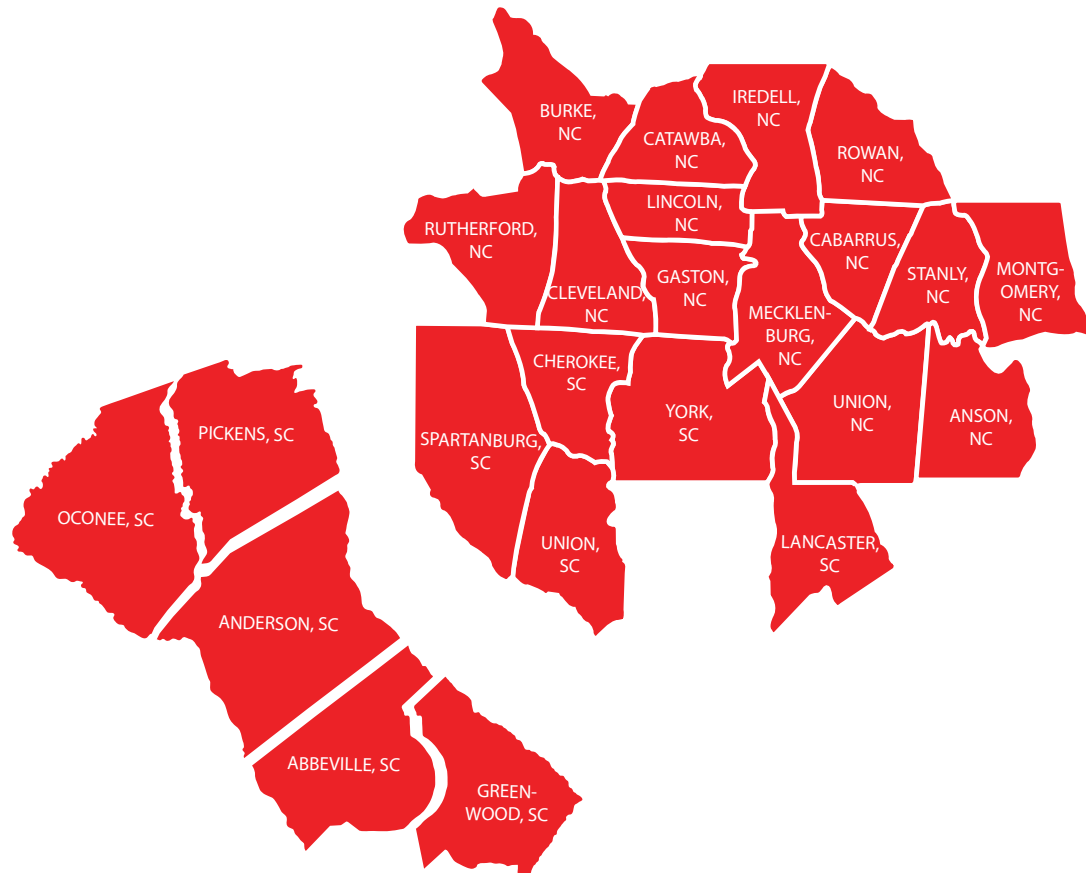

# New Anderson Branch

In fiscal year 2019-2020, Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina was asked to begin providing services in five new upstate counties in South Carolina. These counties, including Abbeville, Greenwood, Anderson, Oconee, and Pickens, joined our other SC counties of York, Lancaster, Union, Cherokee and Spartanburg. Along with the 14 counties we serve in North Carolina, including Anson, Burke, Cabarrus, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Iredell, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, Montgomery, Rowan, Rutherford, Stanly, and Union, our food bank is now responsible for 24 counties in the Carolinas.

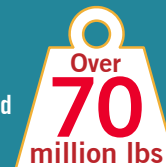

## GIVING MONEY

While most of the food we distribute is donated, we have costs to transport and receive it, keep proper records, conduct appropriate inspections to ensure food safety, and sort and prepare the food for sharing with our partner agencies. Financial donations help to cover these costs.

In 2019-2020 over 70 million pounds of food was distributed to neighbors in need.



SHFBM has over 800 partner agencies including soup kitchens, emergency pantries, homeless shelters, senior programs, and low-income daycares.



## Did You Know?

In 2019-2020 Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina had 280 different programs in place dedicated to ending child hunger. Making sure every child in our region has enough to eat every day is the number one goal of our food bank.



## Did You *Know*?

In 2019-2020 Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina's Second Helping Program distributed 24,742 boxes full of healthy, ready-to-eat foods to 22 senior distribution sites in 16 counties.

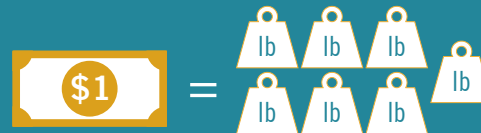

Every \$1 donated provides 7 pounds of food to neighbors in need.

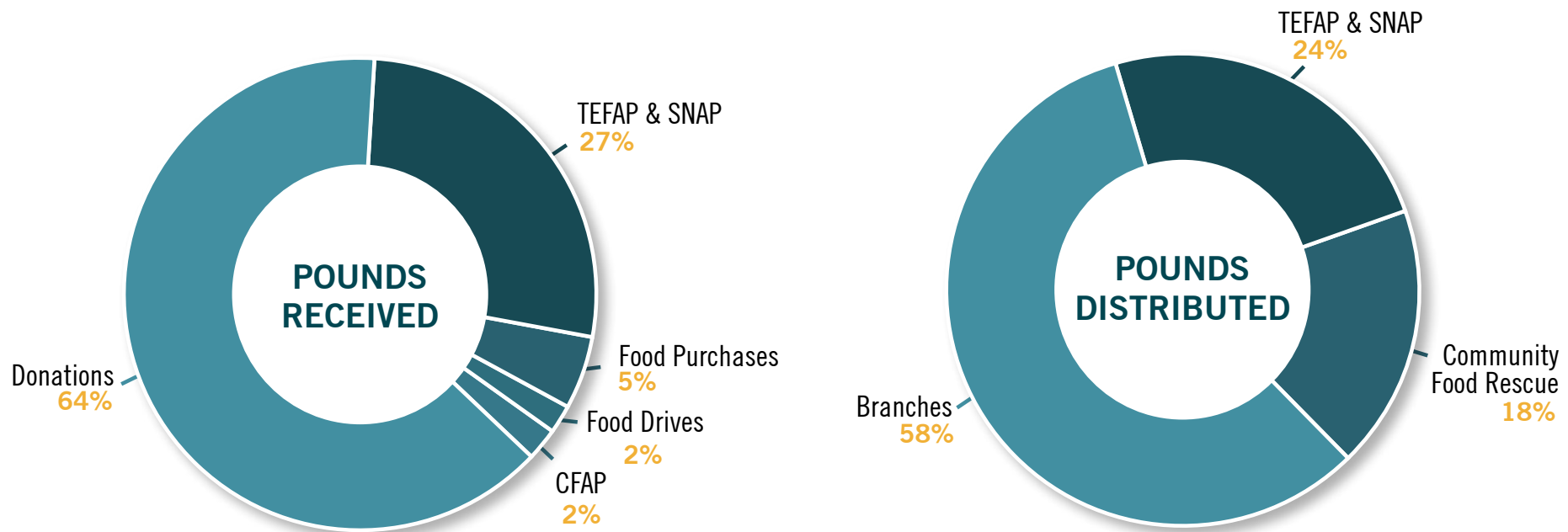


Food and fund drives provided the equivalent of more than 8.2 million pounds of food to neighbors in need.
