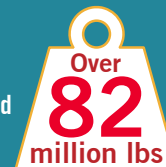

GIVING MONEY

While most of the food we distribute is donated, we have costs to transport and receive it, keep proper records, conduct appropriate inspections to ensure food safety, and sort and prepare the food for sharing with our partner agencies. Financial donations help to cover these costs.

In 2020-2021 over 82 million pounds of food was distributed to neighbors in need.



SHFBM has over 800 partner agencies including soup kitchens, emergency pantries, homeless shelters, senior programs, and low-income daycares.



Did You Know?

In 2020-2021 Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina had 347 different programs in place dedicated to ending child hunger. Making sure every child in our region has enough to eat every day is the number one goal of our food bank.



Did You *Know*?

In 2020-2021 Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina's Second Helping Program distributed 21,589 boxes full of healthy, ready-to-eat foods to 31 senior distribution sites in 15 counties.

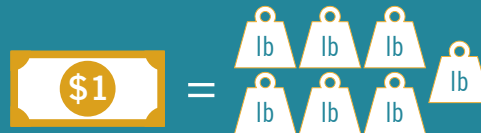

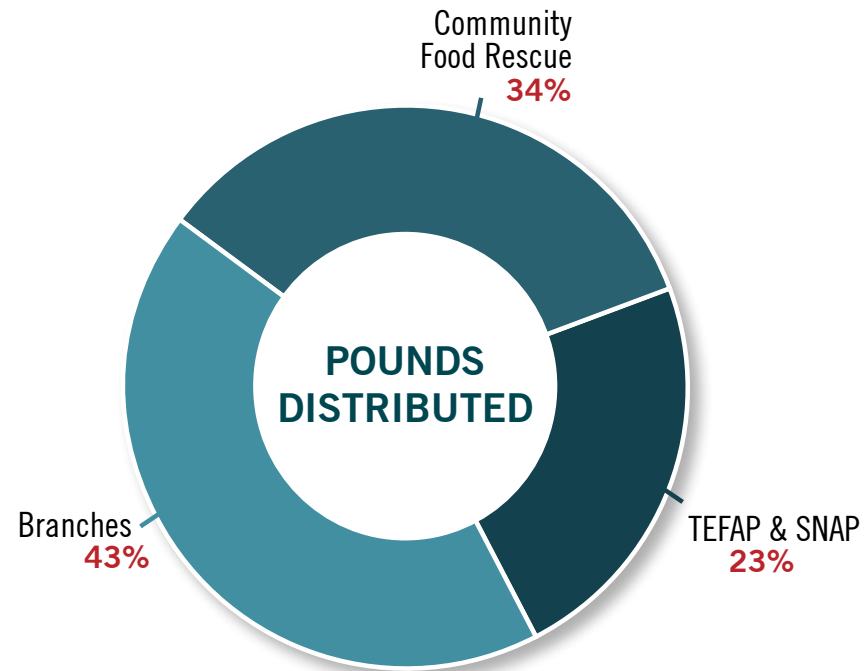
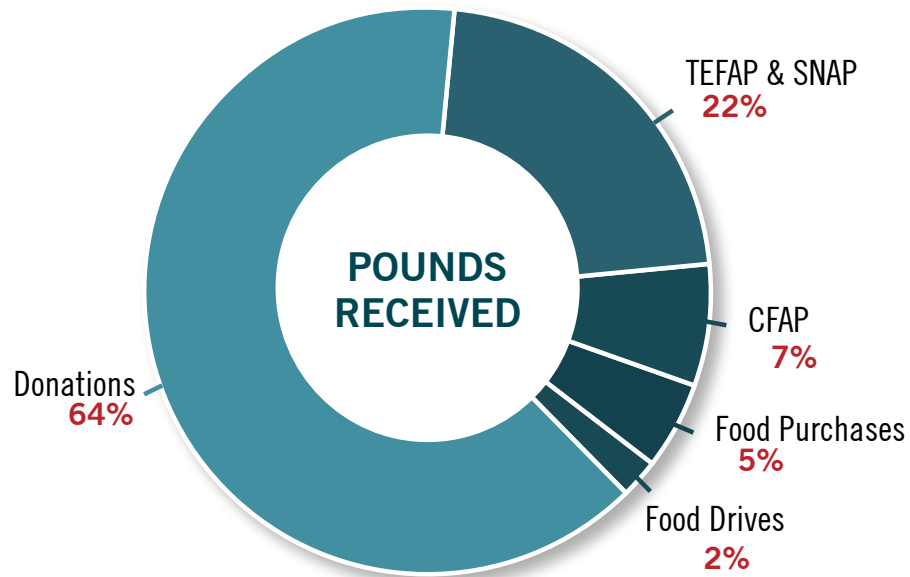
Every \$1 donated provides 7 pounds of food to neighbors in need.

COVID-19 Our Response...16 Months Later



Sixteen months later, the impact of COVID-19 is still being felt throughout our 24 county service region in North and South Carolina. During the first 12 months, we encountered enormous increases in need, less donated food and fewer volunteers to help us keep children, seniors, families, veterans and pets fed.

Just as we were beginning to see some improvement in all of our numbers, a new Delta Variant materialized. Now we are starting to see again some of the same issues we encountered during the first 12 months.

It has become clear to all of us at Second Harvest that our work is far from over where this virus is concerned. We need your continued support and help as we navigate this next phase. We thank you for what we have accomplished so far and ask you to stay with us as we work to ensure no one in our region is hungry.
