Facts At A Glance

- Cabarrus County has a population of 201,590.
- There are 21,771 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 10.8% of the population.
- There are 1,535 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 5.9% of the older adult population.
- There are 10,123 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19.3% of the child population.

Cabarrus County Distribution

In 2016-2017, the Food Bank distributed over 54 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2016-2017, the Food Bank distributed almost 3.1 million pounds to agencies in Cabarrus County.

Cabarrus County Partners

The Food Bank supports 32 programs in Cabarrus County including Cooperative Christian Ministry, Operation Bread Basket, Church of God Children's Home, Salvation Army and Cabarrus County Senior Center.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank sponsors Kids Cafés at the Boys & Girls Club of Cabarrus County and at the Multi-Cultural Community Student Union. The Food Bank also sponsors Backpack programs at Winecoff Elementary School, Carver Elementary School, McAllister Elementary School and McKnight Child Development.

Second Helping Program

The Second Helping Program provides monthly food boxes to homebound seniors in Cabarrus County. These boxes are provided by the Food Bank and delivered by the Cabarrus County Senior Center.
