

Stanly County, NC *Facts* at a glance



- Stanly County has a population of 59,621.
- There are 6,365 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 10.7% of the population.
- There are 961 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8.3% of the older adult population.
- There are 2,409 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 18.6% of the child population.

Stanly County Distribution

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed over 54 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed almost 700,000 pounds to agencies in Stanly County.

Stanly County Partners

The Food Bank supports 26 programs in Stanly County including Stanly Community Christian Ministry, Providence Church of God and Group Homes for the Autistic.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank provides Backpack Programs for students at Locust Elementary School, Oakboro Elementary School, West Stanly Middle School, Endy Elementary School, Millingport Elementary School, Stanly Academy, Stanfield Elementary and Richfield Elementary.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in Stanly County. These boxes are provided by the Food Bank and delivered by Providence Church of God.
