Union County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- Union County, SC has a population of 26,861.
- There are 4,023 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 15% of the population.
- There are 712 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14% of the older adult population.
- There are 1,154 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 21% of the child population.

Union County Distribution

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed over 54 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed almost one million pounds to agencies in Union County, SC.

Union County Partners

The Food Bank supports 10 programs in Union County, SC including the Salvation Army, Union County Council on Aging and Potters Store House.

Child Hunger Programs

Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina sponsors backpack programs at Lockhart Elementary, Monarch Elementary, Foster Park Elementary, Buffalo Elementary and Jonesville Elementary.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in Union County. These boxes are provided by the Food Bank and delivered by Union County Council on Aging.

Spartanburg Branch

The Food Bank opened a branch in Spartanburg County in May 2010. This branch also serves Union County.
