York County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- York County, SC has a population of 261,990.
- There are 30,891 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 11.8% of the population.
- There are 2,190 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 6% of the older adult population.
- There are 11,194 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 17.5% of the child population.

York County Distribution

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed over 54 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed 4 million pounds to agencies in York County.

York County Partners

The Food Bank supports 54 programs in York County including P.A.T.H., Fort Mill Care Center, HOPE, Dorothy Day Soup Kitchen and York County Council on Aging.

Child Hunger Programs

York County has Kids Café sites located within Boys & Girls Club facilities in Rock Hill, Fort Mill and Clover. The Food Bank also provides 21 Backpack Programs in Rock Hill, seven in York, eight in Clover and 10 in Fort Mill.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in York County. The Food Bank provides the boxes, which are delivered by the York County Council on Aging.
