# Anson County, NC *Facts* at a glance



- Anson County has a population of 22,985.
- There are 3,893 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 17% of the population.
- There are 357 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8.4% of the older adult population.
- There are 1,262 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 26.9% of the child population.

## Anson County Distribution

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed over 54 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed 2.3 million pounds to agencies in Anson County.

## Anson County Partners

The Food Bank supports 13 programs in Anson County including Anson Crisis Ministry, Feed My Lambs, Wadesboro Area Community Outreach Ministry, and Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center.

## Child Hunger Programs

Anson County has a Kids Café and Backpack Program site located at Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center. In addition to the backpack Program at Burnsville, Second Harvest also provides backpacks for East Ansonville Elementary School, Morven Elementary School, Wadesboro Elementary School, and Peachland-Polkton Elementary School.
