

Anderson County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- Anderson County has a population of 201,569.
- There are 28,770 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14.3% of the population.
- There are 3,454 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 9.6% of the older adult population.
- There are 9,788 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 21.4% of the child population.

Anderson County Distribution

In 2023-2024, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 3.3 million pounds to agencies in Anderson County.

Anderson County Partners

The Food Bank supports 71 programs in Anderson County including Tabernacle of Faith, Good Neighbor Cupboard, IVA First Baptist, Over Comers Outreach, and Honea Path United Ministries.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank works with United Way of Anderson County to help provide backpacks to school districts throughout the county.

The Food Bank operates a branch in Anderson County. This branch also serves Abbeville, Greenwood, Oconee, and Pickens Counties.
