

Pickens County, SC









- Pickens County has a population of 123,400.
- There are 20,880 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 16.9% of the population.
- There are 1,846 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8.5% of the older adult population.
- There are 3,282 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 13.7% of the child population.

Pickens County Distribution

In 2023-2024, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 3 million pounds to agencies in Pickens County.

Pickens County Partners

The Food Bank supports 32 programs in Pickens County including Gleaning House, Pickens Adventist, New Hope Baptist, The Storehouse, and Littlejohn Community Center.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank supports Backpack Programs for elementary, middle and high school students throughout Pickens County.
