

Anson County, NC











- Anson County has a population of 20,225.
- There are 3,913 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19.3% of the population.
- There are 605 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14.6% of the older adult population.
- There are 1,445 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 33% of the child population.

Anson County Distribution

In 2023-2024, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 2.4 million pounds to agencies in Anson County.

Anson **County Partners**

The Food Bank supports 19 programs in Anson County including Anson Crisis Ministry, Feed My Lambs, South Anson Community Outreach, Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center, and Ebenezer Baptist Church.

Child Hunger Programs

Anson County has a Kids Café and Backpack Program site located at Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center. In addition to the Backpack Program at Burnsville, Second Harvest also provides backpacks for schools throughout the county.
