Facts At A Glance

- Montgomery County has a population of 27,548.
- There are 5,812 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 21.1% of the population.
- There are 800 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19% of the older adult population.
- There are 2,452 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 38.7% of the child population.

Montgomery County Distribution

In 2015-2016, the Food Bank distributed over 50 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2015-2016, the Food Bank distributed over 800,000 pounds to agencies in Montgomery County.

Montgomery County Partners

The Food Bank supports 19 programs in Montgomery County including Mt. Gilead Food Pantry, Montgomery County Council on Aging, the Montgomery Baptist Association and Communities in Schools Backpack Program.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank partners with Communities in Schools of Montgomery County to provide backpacks at Troy Elementary School, Green Ridge Elementary School, Candor Elementary School, Mt. Gilead Elementary School, Star Elementary School, Page Street Elementary School, East Middle School, West Middle School, East Montgomery High School, West Montgomery High School and Montgomery Learning Academy.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in Montgomery County. These boxes are provided by the Food Bank and delivered by the Montgomery Council on Aging.
