Facts At A Glance

- York County, SC has a population of 251,195.
- There are 36,674 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14.6% of the population.
- There are 2,962 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8% of the older adult population.
- There are 11,740 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19% of the child population.

York County Distribution

In 2015-2016, the Food Bank distributed over 50 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 19 county service region.

In 2015-2016, the Food Bank distributed over 3.2 million pounds to agencies in York County.

York County Partners

The Food Bank supports 52 programs in York County including P.A.T.H., Fort Mill Care Center, HOPE, Dorothy Day Soup Kitchen and York County Council on Aging.

Child Hunger Programs

York County has Kids Café sites located within Boys & Girls Club facilities in Rock Hill, Fort Mill and Clover. The Food Bank also provides seven Backpack Programs in York, seven in Clover and nine in Fort Mill. These programs cover all the elementary schools in York, Clover and Fort Mill.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in York County. The Food Bank provides the boxes, which are delivered by the York County Council on Aging.
