Pat's story:

Times are tough. It can be a struggle to buy medicine and food. I rely on what I get from Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina.

Their help is really great during the holidays. I can't afford to go out and buy

a turkey. Knowing I can get one from the food pantry makes my meal. Now I can feed not only my family, I can invite other friends and family to eat a meal at my house for the holidays.

We all gather at my house for Thanksgiving and Christmas Eve. Anyone that wants to can come. It doesn't have to be family members . . . it can be anybody. I tell my son, "If you know someone that needs something to eat, bring them. There will be plenty."
