# SECOND HARVEST FOOD BANK OF METROLINA ANNOUNCES 40<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION & CAMPAIGN

## Celebration Activities Kicking off September 1, the First Day of Hunger Action Month

(Charlotte, NC) – August 23, 2021 – In September 1981, Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina opened its doors in Charlotte. 40 years later, hunger is at an all-time high due to the COVID-19 pandemic. There has been a significant increase in requests for food since COVID-19 began in March of 2020.

**September, also Hunger Action Month, marks the 40**<sup>th</sup> year of operation for the Food Bank, headquartered at 500-B Spratt Street near Uptown. Since its inception, the food bank has evolved from providing shelf-stable, nonperishable food items, to distributing more than 65 million pounds of fresh produce, meat, and dairy from March 2020 to June 2021. In the past 16 months, the Food Bank has distributed over 110 million pounds of food. Today, Second Harvest has a network of more than 800 partner agencies (food pantries, homeless shelters, soup kitchens, day cares and senior centers) and branch locations in Anderson, SC, Spartanburg, SC, Hickory, NC, and Salisbury, NC.

On September 1st, the Food Bank celebrates 40 years of service to our region with a 2-month birthday celebration and campaign to raise funds, food, volunteerism, and awareness. "Birthdays are unique moments in an organization's life, pauses that encourage reflection on what has come before and excitement for all that lies ahead," says Kay Carter, CEO of Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina. "For 40 years, Second Harvest has distributed food to those in need in our community and we look forward to strengthening that legacy for many years to come."

**From September 1**<sup>st</sup> **to November 1**<sup>st</sup>, the Food Bank will be hosting a variety of celebration activities that corporations, civic clubs, church groups, sororities, fraternities, and individuals can sign-up for to help feed those in need. These opportunities include:

- 40 Fund and/or Food Drives We are looking for 40 companies or groups to host fund and/or food drives. Each group will be provided with commemorative Food Bank 40<sup>th</sup> Birthday supplies and marketing materials.
- **40 Volunteer Group Projects** We are hosting 40 volunteer projects in 40 days (Sept. 1-Nov.1). These projects will be held in a private space for your participants and include LOTS of birthday treats! This is a fundraising opportunity and the chance to be a part of this once-in-a-lifetime celebration!
- **Monthly Donor Challenge** Become a monthly donor and make an ongoing impact. Our goal 400 new recurring donors in 40 days!
