Arby's Foundation Donates \$51,800 to Serve Local Youth

Foundation to allocate proceeds from national Make A Difference fundraiser to support Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina

CHARLOTTE, NC – As part of the annual in-restaurant fundraising program, the Make a Difference campaign, Arby's restaurants raised nearly \$3.4 million to support national organizations dedicated to providing kids the future they deserve.
