The Independence Fund and Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina to Provide Veterans with Nocontact Care Package Drive-thru at Local VA Clinic Thursday Before Memorial Day

WHAT: Beginning in May 2020, The Independence Fund has been honored to serve at-risk Veterans and their families in the Charlotte area by providing no-contact food and supply delivery with the assistance of Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina. Alongside dedicated volunteers and supporters, The Independence Fund is able to help as many families as possible by bringing this national program back to the Charlotte area for their Feeding Independence series. This month's event will be held the Thursday before Memorial Day, May 27th. Cleaning supplies and food will be packaged as part of The Independence Fund's Independence@Home program.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, The Independence Fund launched Independence@Home, a program to directly support its Veterans, Caregivers and families with a range of emergent COVID-19 costs, including food and cleaning supplies. This effort to provide care packages to Veterans is one of several similar collaborative events happening across the country. The Independence Fund recognizes the urgent needs emerging in Veteran homes and continues to evolve their efforts to provide financial assistance, supplies, and critical aid.
